#### SWIM SAFE - BEWARE OF RIP CURRENTS

The National Weather Service Meteorologists have warnings available for New Buffalo area beaches based on heights of waves and how they hit the shoreline. Those most vulnerable to rip currents are swimmers who like to body surf in high waves on Lake Michigan.

Although the New Buffalo Public Beach is staffed by life guards during peak swim times, all swimmers should be aware of how to react if caught in a rip current. If the caught in one of these currents you must react properly. Do not fight the current – swim parallel to the beach until out of the current, then swimming back to shore.

# HISTORY OF NEW BUFFALO

In 1834, one of the first permanent settlers to the area, Captain Wessell Whittaker, ran his schooner Post Boy aground near what is now the village of Grand Beach. The captain and crew found shelter a bit south of there at the present-day Michigan City, Indiana. While traveling north to St. Joseph to report the ship's loss to its underwriters, Whittaker was so struck by the beauty of the area and the natural harbor that he filed claim to a large tract of land around the mouth of the Galien River. Whittaker named it after his hometown of Buffalo. New York.

After laying out plans for the city and gaining partners to develop the area, the value of land rapidly increased in a period of land speculation. This lasted until the Panic of 1837, which brought an abrupt end to most speculative land development in the area for several years. Followed soon after by a severe winter in 1841, the area struggled economically. The western terminus of the Michigan Central Railroad in New Buffalo was completed in 1849. The harbor was improved and the economy flourished briefly until the railroad connection to Chicago was completed in 1853, after which the use of the harbor for shipping declined.

Although the railroad continued to contribute to the local economy, it was not until the 1900's and the age of the automobile that New Buffalo re-established its link to tourism. The area began to be recognized for its vacation and resort potential, resulting in summer cottages, camps and hotels. 1921 saw the opening of the Golfmore Hotel in Grand Beach, rated as one of the finest resorts on the Great Lakes.

In 1934 the State of Michigan recognized New Buffalo as "The Gateway to Michigan" and built a tourist information center here,



at a time when US 12 was the main southwest Michigan artery, intersecting with the final cross-state destination for the historical Red Arrow Highway. With the advent of the Interstate system, I-94 has now paralleled the Red Arrow route. The current Michigan Welcome Center on I-94 at New Buffalo is the busiest in Michigan.



The Oselka family began dredging the harbor and the channel leading to it in the 1960's. By 1975, New Buffalo's safe harbor became a reality and the new Whittaker Street Bridge was dedicated making the New Buffalo Harbor one of the largest harbors in the area.



Between August 5, 1984, and October 26, 2009, Amtrak's Pere Marquette (Chicago—Grand Rapids) stopped in New Buffalo at a station along the old C&O alignment. This station was located approximately seven blocks south of the current station that opened in 2009 at 225 North Whittaker Street. This has allowed people from all over Michigan and Illinois to travel to New Buffalo in a short time to visit the area and even live and commute to work in other locations.
